

AGREEMENT OF MUTUAL COOPERATION

BETWEEN

Iranian Electrical Industry Syndicate (IEIS)

Iranian Electrical Industry Syndicate and Indian Electrical & Electronics Manufacturers' Association (hereinafter referred to as "the Parties") desirous of further promoting trade relations and economic cooperation in the field of Electrical Industry between their two countries on a mutually advantageous basis, have agreed on the following:

Article 01:

The Parties will endeavor to promote trade and economic development between their two countries and consolidate cooperation between both Parties.

Article 02:

The Parties will facilitate the exchange of periodical publications, and up-to-date information and materials concerning trade economy cross-investments, and technology in their home markets.

Article 03:

Each Party will assist in arranging contacts between member companies having mutual business interests.

Article 04:


The two Parties agreed to cooperate and do their best to exchange technology, to facilitate implementation of joint projects in the country of the either side and any third country.

Article 05:

This agreement will enter into force on the date of its signing, and will remain valid unless either Party gives the other Party a written notice six months prior to termination. Two originals were written in English and signed in.
