The objective of the meeting was to review the lists of the equipment for which no capacity exists in India and are being imported and also identify the prospective manufacturers. Senior officials from NTPC, PGCIL and CEA were also present in the meeting. Mr. Neeraj Nanda, Vice- President, IEEMA shared his views and also gave industry inputs that will make demand visible and give confidence to the industry to further invest.

Mr. Sunil Misra, DG, IEEMA; Mr. J. Pande, DDG, IEEMA and Mr. Akeel Khan Sr. Executive Officer were also present in the meeting. As an outcome of the discussion, it was decided to call the meeting of the prospective manufacturers for consultation.

Meeting on Manufacturing Hub-Making Power Sector “AatmNirbhar”



29 October 2020: Under the backdrop of AatmNirbhar Bharat, a meeting of prospective manufacturer was held under Chairmanship of Mr. S.K.G Rahate, Additional Secretary, Ministry of Power, Government of India. Participants were informed about the committee on indigenization of electrical equipment. Thereafter two lists including extensive exercises have been prepared. The lists also depict products which are imported on a mandatory basis. Moreover, you will also find a mention of the products which are imported because there is low capacity for their production or because of some other reasons. Mr. Rahate also apprised the participants about the proposed scheme of manufacturing hub where the various incentives will be given by the Government to the Manufacturers to manufacture products for which no capacity exists in India. Mr. Anil Saboo, President-IEEMA; Mr. Vijay Karia, Sr. Vice President-IEEMA presented their views and concerns of the industry. The meeting was attended by more than 100 participants form various organization. Mr. Rahate appreciated the support extended by IEEMA in whole exercise related to Indigenization of Electrical equipment.
