**Sub: Your Order No. 386 dated 22<sup>nd</sup> May 2021, regarding no permission to operate Industrial units during complete lockdown**

We are writing with reference to your order no. 386, dated 22<sup>nd</sup> May 2021 (attached), where-in it has been instructed that during the complete lockdown export units, units which have export commitments or export orders and their vendor units providing inputs to such industries will not be permitted to operate.

Supply of electricity is an essential service and all industrial activities related to manufacturing, supplies, services and maintenance of electrical equipment also need to be considered as essential services and continuous operations.

**IEEMA therefore requests the Government of Tamil Nadu to allow manufacturing, supply and functioning of following products, which are essential for Generation, Transmission and Distribution of Power:**

- Transmission Line Towers
- Conductors
- Boilers, Turbines, Generators
- Motors, A.C. Generators and Generating Sets
- Transformers
- Industrial Electronics
- Capacitors
- Switchgears
- Surge Arresters, Lighting Arresters, Voltage Limiters and Surge Suppressors
- Electric Lamps
- Cables and Winding Wires
- Insulators & Fittings
- Measuring and Indicating Instruments
- Elevators and Escalators
- Energy Meters
