- There is a concept of sharing the information through Software Bill of materials (BOM), where requirement for source code can be eliminated
- Testing infrastructure needs to be placed before we talk about various standards and products to be tested
- There is a Need a lab on IEC 62443 and if the product is not critical, testing can be exempted.

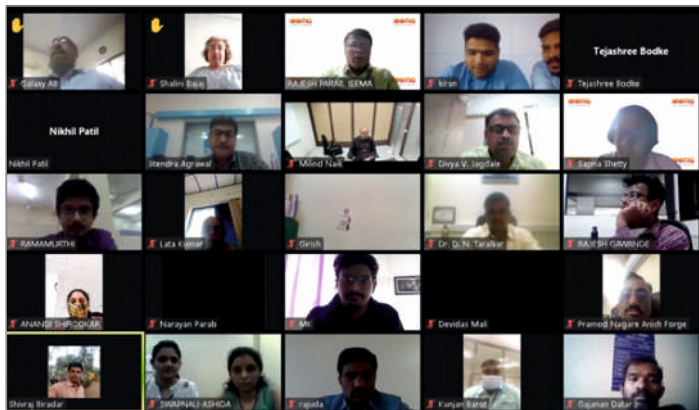
- DoT does not require source code. It is required only by testing lab during the testing process
