meeting was attended by 33 members from 24 organisations.






IEEMA Pavillion at Enlit Africa Digital Event





What causes of BLACK FUNGUS



The Ministry of Health has confirmed that the infection is being detected among people who are recovering or have recovered from COVID-19.

People undergoing oxygen therapy in ICU, where a humidifier is used are more at risk due to exposure to moisture.

Thus, it is recommended to use sterile water for oxygen therapy.

A weak immunity system, overuse of steroids, voriconazole therapy and uncontrolled diabetes also put people at risk of black fungus infection.

Why and how it affects Covid-19 patients during or post-recovery?

Medicines used in treating Covid-19 tend to bring down the count of lymphocytes. Lymphocytes are one of the three types of white blood cells whose job is to defend our body against disease-causing pathogens such as bacteria, viruses, and parasites. The reduced count of lymphocytes leads to a medical condition called lymphopenia, making way for opportunistic fungal infection in Covid-19 patients.

The prime symptom of the black fungus includes discolouration of the oral tissues, tongue, gums, stuffy nose, severe pain, swelling of face, heaviness below the eyes, discomfort, fever and headache.

Maintain oral hygiene
