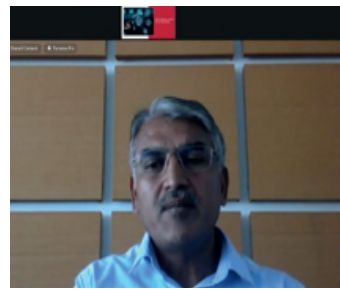
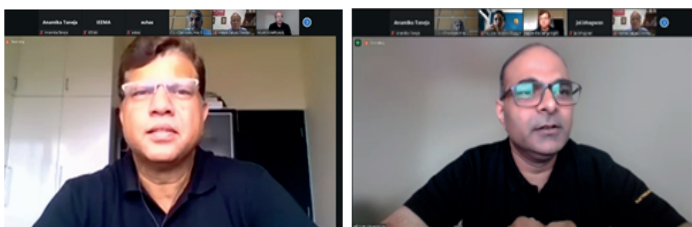
## Webinar session on Metals Market Outlook

Government initiatives like AatmaNirbhar Bharat and Make in India have provided a major boost to the Railways sector. Indian Railways have worked towards ushering transformational changes across all the areas of its operations and management. Major expansion plans are on the pipeline with the Union Budget outlay of Rs 1.1 Lakh crore for 2021-22. The focus areas include development of railway infrastructure, throughout enhancement, augmentation of speed of trains, signaling systems, development of terminal facilities, improvement of

passengers' facilities and amenities, safety works of road over bridges and road under bridges etc.

# DENGUE FEVER

SYMPTOMS | CAUSES  
PREVENTION | TREATMENTS

*Dengue is a mosquito-borne viral infection spread through the bite of an infected Aedes species that is common in warm, tropical climates.*

### Symptoms

Symptoms of dengue may be observed around 4–10 days after the bite of an infected mosquito. Common symptoms are like that of the flu, with patients experiencing:

- High Fever
- Fatigue
- Rashes
- Headaches
- Pain behind the eyes
- Muscle and Joints pain
- Vomiting or Nausea

### Prevention

#### People should:

- Wear clothing that covers the body well
- Keep mosquitoes out of the house by placing insect screens over doors and windows
- Apply insect repellents
- Sleep under a mosquito net
- Keep the water tanks covered
- Do not allow water to stagnate
- Keep your surroundings clean
