The meeting was attended by 40 members, the important points discussed during the meeting were: confirmation on costing of revised PV formula of Distribution Transformer and discussion on CRGO price calculation, proposal to discontinue old PV formula for non-BIS/non-BEE Distribution Transformers, State of Industry and Industry size estimation of DT industry for FY20-21, discussion on TRAFOTECH-DT/Technical webinars from DT Division.

Keep your Eyes HEALTHY ,

Use proper lighting



Reduce interior lighting by using fewer light bulbs lower intensity bulbs and tubes. Reduce exterior light by closing window shades or blinds. Avoid working under

bright fluorescent lights. Use a table lamp that provides softer, indirect lighting.

Reduce glare

Glare from light reflecting back from your screen or other surfaces in the room can contribute to computer eye

strain. Install an anti-glare screen protector. If you wear glasses, wear lenses with anti-reflective (AR) coating.

Upgrade your display

Adjust the brightness of the screen to a comfortable level same as the brightness of your surroundings.



Blink frequently



Blink frequently to remoisten the surface of your eyes and avoid dry eye symptoms.

In order to reduce your risk of dry eyes during computer use, train yourself to blink after reading every two or three paragraphs on your screen.

Use computer glasses

Computer glasses can be very helpful as they reduce your exposure to potentially harmful blue light emitted by digital devices.
